How to Report Map Errors

The data behind navigation systems and mapping sites come from a variety of third-party vendors. Many of the vendors allow users to supply feedback to update mapping issues or errors. Common mapping issues include incorrect addresses or road names, roads or address points in the wrong location, etc. Once feedback is supplied, the vendor reviews the information and either accepts or rejects the map update. When possible, it is advantageous to supply supporting documentation. Please note, there is NO guarantee the vendor will accept the change submitted.

Report an Error to Google Maps

Go to [Google Maps](#), click '**Send Product Feedback**' found on the bottom right-hand corner of the site. You need sign-in to the site to submit a correction.

Report an Error to HERE

Register as a [HERE Map Creator](#), navigate to your area of concern, and utilize the tools (typically on right side of screen) to report a problem or issue a correction.

Report an Error to MapQuest

If you cannot find an address in MapQuest, contact their [Customer Support](#) team. MapQuest receives their map and road data from HERE. You can also report an error using the instructions above to report an error to HERE.

Report an Error to TomTom

While you may think of TomTom as a GPS company, they also create maps and road data used in websites and GPS units. To report an error to TomTom, visit their [Map Share Reporter](#) website. A TomTom account is required.
